

When specifying leather, the COM conversion to COL is 1:18 (i.e., 1 yard of fabric measuring 36”x54” = 18 square feet of leather).

True the math isn’t precise because 1 yard equals 1944 square inches or 13.5 square feet. But because leather is irregular in shape the industry adds a waste factor.

Below are some guidelines for quickly estimating how many square feet you’ll need for a particular piece of furniture. Check with your upholsterer/manufacturer for specific requirements.
